- Should you wish to engage on social media while identifying as a Freedom Fighters Arts' parent, student or employee, you may only do so with integrity, respect, and adhere to our Data Protection / Privacy Policy. Any content revealing or referring to sensitive Freedom Fighters Arts' information is not allowed to be shared online.
- Any comments or posts perceived to be obscene, defamatory, threatening, harassing, discriminatory or hateful towards Freedom Fighters Arts staff, students or families may subject the owner to disciplinary or legal action.
- While affiliated with our school we will not tolerate any posts that are racially, sexually, physically, politically, or religiously offensive.
- All matters pertaining directly to the studio – whether it be fees, scheduling, placements, or performance opportunities – may not be communicated via social media. We have an open-door policy and encourage all communication, complaints, and feedback to be communicated to the Director via email or in person.
